- What it means to be humble:
 - Agreeing with God on who He says He is and who He says you are.
 - Having a modest estimate of your own importance.
 - Remember that your gifts, talents, and everything is from God.
 - Acceptance of your own weakness, and recognition of God's strength.
 - Knowing you are helpless without God, but with God all things are possible.
 - Casting your anxieties and relying on God while remaining sober-minded. (see 1 Peter 5:7-8)
 - Following Christ, doing things God's way (obedience), and resisting the enemy.
- What humility is not:
 - Thinking less of yourself or playing small and calling it humble.
 - Intentionally devaluing yourself.
 - Discrediting yourself to appear humble.



- Being puffed up with pride or knowledge.
- An increased importance of yourself and your own way.
- False Humility. Doing good for others to see.
- True and honest humility is important because it's the example modeled for you by Christ. True and honest humility keeps you in a place of trust and dependence on God, and gives you rest and peace because you aren't striving in our own power.
