II. Answer the following:

III. What is trust?

- The dictionary defines trust as a firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability, or strength of someone or something. In your own words, how do you define trust?

- GotQuestions.org gives the Biblical definition of trust as believing in the promises of God in all circumstances, even in those where the evidence seems contrary. Do you believe God is deserving of your trust? Why or why not?

IV. Who do you trust?

- It's appropriate to trust those who have proven themselves reliable and consistent at doing what they say they're going to do. What are the characteristics of someone you trust?

- It's difficult to trust someone you don't know. Trust is foundational to healthy relationships, whether it's a relationship with other people or with God. The more you experience God's love, grace, and truth, the more you will grow to trust Him. What are some steps you can take to get to know God better?



V. How do you show you trust something or someone?

- When you trust God, you should obey Him. Trust in God is shown in your actions. **Read James 2:14-20**, and in the space provided, write out how you plan on showing your faith and trust in God.
